The 2012 Aloxe-Corton 1er Cru Les Vercots comes from a half-hectare of 45-year old vines. It has a rounded, generous bouquet with plenty of fruite here. The palate is very well balanced with good weight in the mouth: tightly knit tannins, a fine line of acidity and lovely pure black fruit on the finish makes this a delicious 2012. Just lovely!

The 2012 Corton-Bressandes Grand Cru comes from a 0.73-hectare parcel of 35-year old vines that is raised in around 30% new oak. It has a lovely, rather regal bouquet with broody black fruit that open nicely in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins, lively black fruit, a lovely citric seam and great nervosite towards the finish.

The 2012 Corton Clos du Roi Grand Cru comes from 0.60-hectare of vine located just next to the Hospices' vines. It has a more feminine, slightly more rounded bouquet compared to the Bressandes at the moment, the fruit leaning a little more to the red. The palate is very well balanced with a firm backbone. There is plenty of spice tinged black and red fruit with a generous sprinkle of white pepper over the long, tender finish. Excellent.

The 2012 Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru comes from 0.75-hectare of vineyards planted in the Pernand-Vergelesses: two parcels, one just in front of the "Le Charlemagne" restaurant. It has a very mineral-driven bouquet that is tightly wound at the moment, with a subtle walnut note scampering around in the background. The palate is medium-bodied with a very pure, quite spicy entry with notes of dried honey and nutmeg. Good weight in the mouth here, nicely balanced with a crisp, tense finish, this is a very fine Corton-Charlemagne that should age well.

The 2012 Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Clos Berthet is a monopole of the domaine: 1-hectare of white premier cru and half a hectare of red that is for reason unbeknownst to all but the authorities, village cru. This has a fragrant, floral bouquet with subtle tropical fruit: peach and touches of passion fruit. It is nicely defined and generous. The palate is very lively and effervescent, with well-judged acidity and a lovely peach-tinged finish that is married beautifully with the 25% oak. What a lovely wine, especially the bitter lemon note on the aftertaste.
